



The event is very much focused on nature, local environment and local traditions. We also have a wide variety of hands on activities in place, such as rope making, willow weaving, cyanotype photographic printing and learning to play the steel drums.

On the Friday evening there will be live music, local food stalls and a bonfire, followed by the main Country Fair on the Saturday. We are inviting providers, stall holders, speakers, local musicians and sponsors to register an interest in taking part either on Friday and or Saturday.

We have of course been fundraising for this

Melplash Show 2025, A FRESH LOOK

I haven't been to the Melplash Show since I was a teenager, so attending on behalf of the Bridport Flyer on the 178th anniversary of the show was a welcome opportunity to revisit. Having travelled a distance, we were relieved to find readily available, well organised parking on site, with only a short walk across the river to the show itself. The one-day show is held on a Thursday, historically half-day closing in Bridport, and there was a lot to see during the day.

Following my personal interests, the first destination was the craft tent where there was an interesting mix of displays; sea -glass, textile crafts, jewellery, prints, cards, wood turning, and several ranges of pottery. Amongst these were some attractive candle holders made in Symondsbury by Lauren Norris who had brought her Wylde Ceramics to the show for the first time, and Country Craft's pastel coloured children's clothing, whose frilly sweatshirts printed with tractors were both unusual and popular. Delicate, colourful sculptures from Zimbabwe made from recycled drink cans caught my eye, and it was inspiring to hear how these are helping improve the lives of the skilled craftspeople who make them.

There were so many food offerings to choose from, ranging from burgers, fish and chips to pancakes, venison, game and more exotic Caribbean or Persian fusion food as well as confectionery, ice cream and cakes. However, we opted for Rise bakery as it was on our route and enjoyed an early lunch of coffee, a generously filled sausage roll and a delicious almond croissant. Coincidentally, we sat next to the family of one of the bakers, who explained that the bakery is based in Bridport and has an outlet just up the road from the showground. That the Melplash is a family show was further demonstrated by the smiles received by the toddler in a backpack who, unseen by his Mum whilst

she waited to be served, randomly lobbing pieces of banana bread at unsuspecting diners.

We also met the owners of Penston Portlands, who had brought their Portland sheep to exhibit at the show. Although it meant leaving home at 5.30am to make the trip from mid-Devon they were keen to support the show which still maintains a specific class for Portland sheep, now classified as a rare breed. On our way to the Countryside Arena to see the yurts that had won the Rural Crafts Competition we spotted some interesting willow

that had won the Rural Crafts Competition we spotted some interesting willow weaving, carts, wheelbarrows and even a wheeled bench. On leaving the arena we dropped in to the Dorset Guild of Weavers, Spinners and Dyers, before moving on to admired the Alpacas. Whilst walking back towards the vintage car field we were entertained by Morris dancers, a town crier, Spiderman and music by St Swithun's Band.

Any agricultural show necessitates a wander around the animal pens, and my interest in textiles led me to the sheep. It was a very hot day so it was good to see that many exhibitors were using gazebos to provide much needed shade. It was the first time I had seen a red skinned Rouge de L'Ouest in real life, but the Kerry Hills with their black facial markings and the curly Greyface Dartmoors were particularly appealing. A short walk from the sheep brought us to the goat tent, where a visitor was taking a brief rest, oblivious to a goat discreetly nibbling at her skirt.

There was so much to see that we missed the heavy horse classes, but managed to catch them in the grand parade, still majestic in their brass and harness. Tea time found us having a cuppa at the retro WVS mobile canteen, which had been converted from a 1936 Beardmore Mk 4 taxi during WWII.



DT6 AREA MAP



Calling All "SAMWAYS" in Bridport

Carol Thorne (nee' Samways) is trying to find her family!

The Bridport Flyer received a lovely message from Carol Thorne of Chickerell, Weymouth, requesting help.

From Carol -

"We start with Henry Samwaies (surname spelt differently back then) 1595.

Six generations later -

Thomas born 1744. Married Hannah Hanford 5/11/1769.

They had 6 sons and 2 daughters.

My line comes off their first born -Richard Samways b. 1770

Richard married Sarah Masters 16/4/1792 in Wraxall.

One of their sons URIAH is my line. Uriah b. 1820

He married twice. 1st wife was Priscilla Rose they had one daughter Mary.

Priscilla died and Uriah then married Diana (or Dinah) Drew.

Uriah and Diana moved around Dorset and into Somerset following work on farms -

Netherbury, Wraxall, Winsham, Chard.

Their 6th son. Frederick Samways, born 1864 was my Grandads Grandfather!

Frederick married Mary Jane Wallis in Loscombe in 1892.

They had 9 children.

Their 7th child, Charles Edward was my Grandfather, born at South Bowood, married Winifred Vallance in Weymouth in 1927.

Their children included my father, Charles Wilfred, and his twin brother Edward sadly who died aged 2yrs.

My father told me we

and Clive Samways of the Fisheries. Also one of dad's uncles or cousins was Mayor of Bridport at one time.


Samways is synonymous with farm labourers & fishermen I believe.

Dad was a postman for 40yrs in Weymouth and as a child he took me in the van out to Abbotsbury and the surrounding farms delivering post. He had an Aunt who lived in Abbotsbury I remember.



Town centre traffic management and access improvements in Bridport and Lyme Regis will reduce traffic, improve air quality, and create safer, more attractive environments for walking and cycling. These schemes will be supported by enhancements to the rights of way network enabling more people to enjoy the health benefits of nature, including developing the Maiden Newton to Bridport Trailway. The plan also supports the development of a mobility hub in Bridport, which will integrate active travel with public transport and provide facilities such as cycle parking and travel information."





West Bay Discovery Centre is expecting a busy autumn with lots to interest, inspire, and entertain its visitors.

The Centre's latest exhibition, "Pier Terrace Through Time", is proving popular with visitors. The exhibition runs until March 2026. Pier Terrace is West Bay's most iconic building, and 2025 marks its 140th anniversary. Pier Terrace fascinates local people and visitors in equal measure and has appeared in TV and film. It was built as the first step in a plan to transform Bridport Harbour into West Bay, a popular tourist destination to rival resorts like Bournemouth and Weymouth.

The exhibition explores the social history of those who lived, stayed and worked in Pier Terrace from the Victorian era through to the modern day. It features major events such as the two fires and celebrates the stories of extraordinary women who have been associated with the building, from royalty to rock stars and from landladies to social reformers. One of the most fascinating exhibits is a doll's house that has been transformed to provide a representation of life in Pier Terrace in the 1900s and 1950s. The exhibition provides a snapshot of the Arts and Crafts style, inspired by William Morris.

The Discovery Centre's programme of regular **Thursday morning walking tours** around West Bay continues until the end of October. The tours, which







start at 11 am and last around 90 minutes, cost £5 per person and are led by the Centre's knowledgeable volunteers. The main themes include West Bay's hidden history and a wildlife walk that includes looking at what is "flying or in flower". Find more details about these, and everything at the Centre, on its website or Facebook page.

Over the October half-term week, the Centre invites younger visitors for a spooky spider-themed Halloween visit. All week, you can go on a spider hunt – they are hidden all over the centre.

Over the winter, the Discovery Centre will be resuming its popular programme of monthly talks at the Salt House in West Bay. Details of these, which feature local subjects, will be published on its Facebook page and website.

The Discovery Centre operates on a not-for-profit basis, and admission is free, though donations from visitors are very welcome to help meet the Centre's running costs. It is open 11 am-4 pm Tuesday to Sunday each week until the end of October, then weekends only in November. It relies on a team of enthusiastic volunteers, most of whom volunteer for 2.5 hours, once a fortnight.



Bridport Youth and Community Centre

- Not Only a Youth Club

I believe in the power of community. Research shows strong communities cope better in difficult times. With today's challenges, especially climate change, this matters more than ever.

Many of you may know me from Sustainable Bridport, Bridport Fashion Revolution, or my work as a Co-op Pioneer. I'm now Community Development Coordinator for Bridport Youth and Community Centre—a role I took on because this is a great place to build connections.

The Centre, on Gundry Lane, has been a youth club since 1968. When Dorset County Council withdrew funding in 2016, local volunteers formed a Charitable Trust to keep it running and expand it for wider community use. Today we host activities and services for all ages.

From here, Bridport Food Bank stores and sorts food packages. Bridport Clothes Bank also operates from the Centre, with rails across town and a monthly Saturday opening. Bridport Fashion Revolution has become the Bridport School of Regenerative Fashion, which stores donated haberdashery here for community use.

We also host:

- Stay & Play (Mon & Fri mornings, term time) - toddlers socialising, parents/carers connecting
- Jurassic Amateur Boxing training three times a week
- ASCape Club activities for autistic people and families
- The Space youth project monthly LGBTQ+ meetups
- U3A groups painting, table tennis, and more







- Age UK Brain Training on Tuesdays
- Forget Me Not singing group dementiafriendly sessions on Thursdays
- Games group for 18–25ish year olds, first Tuesday of the month

And yes, we're still a youth club too—on Wednesday and Friday evenings.

Our facilities are suitable for most purposes, from meetings to parties and dance classes, with very competitive hire prices – including cheaper rates for charities and not for profit organisations.
