

From Dowell Street, Honiton we took a drive out through Awliscombe, climbing to Hembury Cross, then turned right and ascended to the carpark in the woods at the very top of the hill.

This area is the site of the ancient hill-top fort and village of Hembury, first settled by Neolithic people before 3,000 BC - that is over 5,000 years ago! The defensive ramparts were first constructed around 500 BC.



Surrounding the carpark are woods managed by Forest and Land Management Ltd, under sustainable forestry principles. This part of the hilltop was first planted as a planned wood in the 1950's.

Our first part of this walk is a simple 15 minute tour of the woods. We went anti-clockwise from the carpark, following the ancient banks and beech trees, soon turning left and then left again, dropping down on the west side of the woods. The growth of trees blocks the views to the west, but this is still a very pleasant stroll. At the bottom, turn left again heading towards a bank above the sunken lane coming up from Hembury Cross, then climb back to the carpark, where a welcome bench awaits you.

We then crossed the road and entered the private woods leading to the main part of Hembury Hill Fort. Despite being private, the landowners welcome considerate walkers and visitors. There are also public footpaths across the hillfort.

The extensive ramparts and excavations extend southwards, and make very pleasant walking under the shelter of the beech canopy. Most of the ramparts are both steep and deep, so exercise caution as you proceed. We kept to the left (east) boundary and eventually entered the central plateau – a clear grassed area. This must have been the site of the main village, where both people and animals were protected from attack by the ramparts. Keep heading south/ south west and you will come to an area with stunning views across the Devon countryside, and the outline of both Dartmoor and Exmoor visible on the horizon. We dwelt a while here, taking in the vista, before returning across the plateau, and back into the shelter of the beech trees. These are living working woods, where, on our visit, essential tree maintenance was being carried out.

SOUTH WEST AIRFIELDS HERITAGE TRUST

"PRESERVING AVIATION HISTORY FOR FUTURE GENERATIONS"

The aim of the South West Airfields Heritage Trust is to educate about aviation history in South West England. It has two Heritage Centres in East Devon – one at **Dunkeswell** airfield and the other at the old **Upottery** airfield by the village of Smeatharpe.

The Trust's volunteers having been busy during 'lockdown' refurbishing the exhibits and displays ready to receive visitors when they open again on 22nd July.



UPOTTERY HERITAGE CENTRE



Dunkeswell was the home of Fleet Air Wing 7, US Navy with three squadrons of Liberator patrol bombers. The museum holds a photographic archive of life on the only WW2 US Naval Air Base in Europe. As well as photographs, it has authentic

uniforms, films, artefact's, models, dioramas, WW2 memorabilia and archive film of the airfield. There is also a feature about Lieutenant Joe Kennedy, older brother of President John F Kennedy, who was killed on active service in

Upottery airfield hosted the C-47 Skytrain aircraft of the 439th Troop Carrier Group of the 9th US Army Air Force in 1944. The museum has a photographic archive documenting the major role the airfield played during the night of 5th June and on D-Day 6th June, dropping paratroopers of the 101st Airborne Division – the 'Screaming Eagles' that were featured in the TV series, Band of Brothers. It is housed in

one of the original Nissen huts that had been part of the Group Headquarters.

The exhibition features a collection of photographs of aircraft and personnel preparing for the invasion. Many are on loan from the family of the late Colonel Charles H Young, the war-time commander of the 439th Troop Carrier Group.

A SAD FAREWELL TO LOCAL HONITON HERO, OWEN COX

Director WILLIAM FLINT and the team at Bluebird Care Honiton wish to celebrate the life of local man, Owen Cox, who passed away in July, aged 99.

Owen Cox was a second world war RAF veteran, an author and an all-round lovely man. Owen was 17 and working as a Junior Clerk for Devon County Council when war broke out. Like many men, he was desperate to join the RAF, despite his young age.

He said: "If you volunteered, you had to get committee approval from the council to secure your position after the war. If you registered as a conscientious objector, you had to leave."

After receiving permission, Owen signed up to the RAF on his 18th birthday and began service on 6th January 1941.

From 1941 to 1943, Owen served as a Wireless Radio Operator. On 1st October 1943, Owen and his companions; Mac, Jock and Jack, conducted their last mission.

The team were bombing in Italy when the Boston 3A they were flying was caught in a violent electrical storm. The plane was off-course and low on fuel when they decided to 'ditch' (land on the sea) off the coast of Sicily.


Owen recalls: "Jock suddenly shouted 'HIT'... I felt a violent blow on the head and nothing more till I came to and found myself floating around in the sea, by myself."

When he was hospitalised after the accident, Owen remembers being

mischievous with the matron in the hospital. He and his pals asked the nurse for fairy stories at bedtime, and Owen stood up to the warrant officer to get himself some clean clothes and shoes.

Owen shared many anecdotes and his autobiography with his carers. He was always smiling and happy and had a story and a joke for everyone.

Allhallows Museum in Honiton High Street

has an astonishing wealth of local heritage information and artefact's packed into the oldest building in Honiton. Founded seventy five years ago this November, the Museum is still run entirely by volunteers who work to preserve the heritage of the people of Honiton and the surrounding district.

The 20th century is history now.
We always welcome Honiton related
artefact's, documents and photographs from
times gone by to ensure that visitors can
enjoy them in the future.

The focus for the Museum is all things Honiton. We hold the largest collection of Honiton lace in the world, tracing the history of lacemaking in Honiton from the 17th century to the present day. You can see the first written evidence of lace production in Honiton; a brass plaque from the tomb of James Rodge, dated 1617. There are also examples of black lace worn by the Victorians as a symbol of mourning and a scarlet nightdress which was owned by Wallis

Simpson, who King Edward abdicated the throne for in 1936.

The museum also displays fossils and historic artefact's from archaeological digs in the area. The most famous being the Honiton Hippo. The fossilised remains of seventeen hippos were found during the construction of the bypass in 1965. The hippos are thought to have lived in the area during a warm interlude in the Ice Age, when England had a climate similar to that in Africa today.

In the Murch Gallery numerous examples of Honiton Pottery can be seen. Another display showcases historic objects unearthed by the East Devon Metal Detecting Club, including Bronze Age, Roman, and medieval finds. Other displays include a furnished Victorian dolls house, local trade tokens and coins, war memorabilia, Hot Penny Day, and children's toys. There is a display on Allhallows School, featuring school mementoes and perhaps their most famous student; Sir Arthur Travers (Bomber) Harris, head of Bomber Command in WWII.

Visit soon, you will be very welcome and entry is FREE for everyone.



only option is to give up, open the gin and watch for the 119th time the episodes of Midsomer Murders and Poirot which is all that TV commissioning editors believe the old deserve.

It's odd that society is so patronising and inconsiderate of the over-65s. Apart from the fact that there are so many of us (around 22% of the population of England and Wales and around 33% of the population of Honiton) that you'd think we could command greater attention, there's also the matter of it doesn't make good business sense according to a study by the International Longevity Centre the UK's over-65's spending on goods and services is roughly £120 Billion a year.

G7 SUMMITS CARBIS BAY

Carbis Bay in Cornwall hosted the G7 Summit in early June. World leaders from the G7 nations (the UK, USA, Canada, Japan, Germany, France and Italy plus the EU and guest nations Australia, India, South Korea and South Africa) came together to discuss new agreements with the overarching aim to 'Build Back Better'.

An area of priority for the G7 Summit was 'tackling climate change and preserving the planet's biodiversity', however it was felt by some that the G7's commitments lacked the funding to see this priority achieved. The G7 leaders reaffirmed their commitments to limit global warming to 1.5C, in line with the Paris Agreement, and to restore 30% of the natural world by 2030. Pledges were also made to end direct government support for unabated coal plants by the end of this year.

Despite these pledges the G7 fell noticeably short in commitments to provide climate finance. Climate finance is funding provided by rich countries to developing nations, to support the transition away from fossil fuels and cope against the impacts of climate change. Some funding was allocated: it was announced that \$2 billion will be made available to help countries move away from fossil fuels, however it was unclear in statements from the G7 whether this is new or old money.

Furthermore, despite the recent report by the International Energy Agency which said that countries must stop new fossil fuel exploration by the end of 2021 to remain below the 1.5C threshold, the G7 did not call for a halt on new fossil fuel exploration.

Overall, the G7 Summit was light on climate policy. These outcomes raise the importance of the upcoming UN climate talks COP26 being held in Glasgow this November.




