# CROWD\_FUNDING UPDATE FROM NEIL BARNES

Yes we did it!

I really can't thank you enough for helping me to raise this money. The initial target was £1500-£2000 which was reached in just over six hours! with the final total being a magnificent £5242.

In a meeting I had with the National Trust last week, we decided to not only replace the original two wheelchair friendly benches that were destroyed at Hive Beach but add another making three. Because of the damage caused by the storm to the foreshore and Fisherman's Green making it rather unsafe, the National Trust are currently formulating plans to re-site the benches in a place that will be more suitable and less prone to extreme weather events.

Some of you may be aware of my initial campaign to help get my daughter Lucy and other wheelchair users better access to our beaches. Part of the campaign resulted in two

further benches that were placed on the Esplanade at West Bay. I am now intending adding to those with a new bench situated overlooking the harbour in front of Pier Terrace utilising the extra money that was raised. This viewpoint is excellent for watching boats come and go from the harbour.

The rest of the money I am intending adding to the fund that is raising money for the housing of the wonderful beach wheelchairs which were installed at West Bay earlier this year. There are plans for a permanent structure to be constructed that will house the wheelchairs near the slipway of the outer harbour.

Once again, thank you so much for your contribution.

# **CHARMOUTH HERITAGE COAST CENTRE**

We had a busy autumn seeing our 100,000th visitor of 2023, Myles and his family. We gave them a small ammonite gift. We would like to say thank you to all our visitors who came in 2023 and to those who have supported us. Without your support the centre couldn't run, so thank you! We had our most successful Christmas Craft Fair yet in November, as well as our Christmas beach clean with 40 people joining in to help clean up after storm Ciaran. We also had a lecture by our patron Prof Danielle Schreve on ice age mammals of southwest England.

Our centre is only open Fridays, Saturdays, Sundays and Mondays during the Winter and during this time we are continuing with our school's outreach programme and our new landslide display in the education room. You can see in the mock up image, what we hope to achieve, and completion of the landslide is due in February 2024. Our volunteer winter work party are working closely with artist Darrell Wakelam to build the landslide and create relevant information about the local landscapes and geology. You will be able to see Darrell busy building it during the February half term.

We have a new publication available. Following on from our recent landscape's miniseries, we introduce a more historical publication in 'The Fossil

Hunters of Charmouth'. This 40-page booklet explores fossil hunters past and present, spanning 200 years. Currently only available in our gift shop and will soon be available on the online store aswell. We have also published a history of Charmouth Heritage Coast Centre, exploring the early days of our building in the 1800s, and the Charmouth Family Geology Trail which looks at Charmouth's history of geologists and fossil hunters around the village. Our next publication is in the works, so watch this space....

February and into Spring 2024 will see us busy with a big beach clean project in conjunction with the Lower Char Community Project and Nurdle.org. Please keep an eye out on our social media, website events calendar and local news for events you can get involved with.

As always, we will be running our programme of fossil walks and marine events in 2024 which you can book via our website. Our recent "fossil finds" cabinet is always being updated, with the latest addition being part of an ichthyosaur skull found by a visitor in October 2023, and a new assemblage of ammonites is coming soon! 2024 is an exciting year for the Centre as it will be our 40th anniversary! We will have some celebrations, so watch out for our events over the year.



# SUSTAINABLE BRIDPORT-Giving Support to Building our Community Resilience in the face of Climate Change.

COP (Conference of the Parties) is a series of United Nations climate change conferences, which have been running since 1990. There is a lot of scepticism around it but generally it is felt that at the least, it keeps the conversation going. Local environmentalist Kit Vaughn has attended many COPs – including this year's, in Dubai. In January 2024, West Dorset Friends of the Earth are putting on an event where he will give an insider's view of events and explain some of the implications.

Meanwhile, what can we continue to do in Bridport? Well the answer to that is, quite a lot!

The Greener Homes Dorset project has been extended to offer visits all year round. So if you are thinking of a big outlay for a heat pump etc, or want to know what insulation would best suit your house, then look at their website www. dorsetcan.org/greener\_homes/

Remember though, there is an energy hierarchy and you can make a massive impact to your carbon footprint AND your bills by doing simple things such as switching off lights when you're not in the room (even LEDs), turning down your thermostat to 18 degrees or below and putting on a jumper.

Bridport Fashion Revolution has now joined many local producers, makers, sellers and interested parties to form the Bridport Fashion and Textiles Network. Our aim is to work towards a more circular



local fashion and textile economy, where fabric can be produced locally and then mended, reused or repurposed to extend its life, and when it really has reached the end, is biodegradable and does not need to be sent to landfill. We have some great events coming early next year in the leadup to the Fashion Revolution Week in April, including:

- A talk from Mary Moore about her DRESS collection. I find it difficult not to slow down and admire the window display in her shop in South Street and here we can find out how the collection began and why those loved clothes continue to live a life.
- A talk about HEREWEAR a project that aims for a holistic approach to establishing a market in the EU for locally-produced textiles made from locally-sourced bio-based materials. Check out their website for ideas about completely new fabrics. https:// herewear.eu/



There is a growing movement around the country to revive the growing and processing of flax to produce linen. Flax was grown extensively in our area in the past. France, Belgium and Portugal still have processing capacity, so is this a local industry we could revive in Bridport? Working with other projects around the country, we would like to start some small scale growing and become part of this bigger conversation. Are you interested in growing a square meter of flax and coming together to look at the possibilities? Follow Bridport Fashion Revolution on Facebook or Instagram to see when seeds are available.



**'Connected Communities'** is an initiative that is looking for 'street ambassadors' to engage 4 to 8 households in your road to embark on the Dorset Green Living Project, where people come together to explore simple but effective ways in which they can reduce their impact on the planet in their everyday lives AND save on their bills. The great thing about this award-winning project is that it also builds connected and resilient communities.

# Get your dog or cat microchipped

You must make sure your dog is fitted with a microchip and registered on a database by the time it's 8 weeks old.

From 10 June 2024, cats in England will need to be microchipped and registered on a database by the time they're 20 weeks old.

You can be fined up to £500 if your dog or cat is not microchipped when they need to be.

Who can microchip your dog or cat

Your pet's microchip must be fitted by a trained professional.

You can ask your vet, local council or local rescue and rehoming centre if they can microchip your dog or cat. They might charge a fee.

What happens when your dog or cat is microchipped

Your pet's microchip contains a number, which will show up whenever your dog or cat is scanned.

You must make sure that your dog or cat is registered on one of the following databases (they all meet government standards):

You'll be asked for your address and contact details when you register your pet on one of these databases.



If you have a dog, it must still wear a collar and tag with your name and address when in a public place.

#### **Updating your details**

You're responsible for keeping your pet's microchip information up to date, for example if you move house.

Contact the database company your dog or cat is registered with to update any of your details.

You might be charged a fee for updating

your pet's microchip information.

Find out where your dog or cat is registered

You can check the microchip number if you do not know which database your pet is registered on.

If you do not have the microchip number, you can ask any of the following to scan your dog or cat for it:

# WEST BAY DISCOVERY CENTRE LOOKS BACK TO 1944

The multi-award winning West Bay Discovery Centre emerges from its winter break on Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> February to coincide with the school half-term holiday.

The Centre's new exhibition "West Bay at War", which will run until June is expected to be very popular. It features both existing and new research about life in West Bay in the period leading up to D Day in June 1944. For seven months in 1943/44 West Bay played host to American soldiers from the second battalion of the 16th Infantry Regiment. The Centre has had unique access to the recollections of one of their number. Sqt. Don Wilson, whose memories are featured in the exhibition, along with those of local people. The exhibition also features the coastal defences against a potential invasion and a look at food rationing.

The Discovery Centre is currently participating in a "House History" project that is being led by the Bridport Heritage Forum. The project involves people researching the history of their houses and the people who lived in them. In our case we are selected Dorset House, which was the largest residential dwelling in the former shipyard on the west side of the harbour. We are now expanding our research to cover other buildings in the shipyard area, and in the process we are uncovering a lot of new historical information.

Over the winter period the Centre is holding a series of public talks. Forthcoming are the South West Coast

Path on Tuesday 20th February at 2.30pm and Churchill's Secret Underground Army - GHQ Auxiliary Units on Wednesday 27th March at 2.30pm. Both will be at the Salthouse in West Bay and tickets will be available in person or online from Bridport Tourist Information Centre at a price of £5.

The Centre operates on a charitable basis. Admission is free though donations from visitors are help the Centre meet its running costs. It also relies on a team of enthusiastic volunteers. 
