



Longevity in Honiton

Death, apart from taxes, is the only guarantee in life. Today the average life expectancy in the UK is 82, which many of us will be lucky enough to reach; a few less will be luckier and go beyond that age, however, very few of us will see our centenary. At the time of writing, according to oldestinbriatin.org, the oldest person in the country, and in fact the world, is super-centenarian Ethel Caterham, aged 116 and, perhaps more interestingly, the 67th is a 107-year-old resident of Honiton.

Over the past few centuries, one would have had a 'good innings' to reach their 70s, some made octogenarians and once or twice in



a generation a fortunate individual would reach their 90s. Whilst more common in modern times to become a nonagenarian, it is still a great rarity, even today, to get your telegram from the King, but going back in time there were people, in Honiton and the surrounding area, who outwitted the Grim Reaper for a lot longer than most.

Perhaps the most famous and oldest example of these is Thomas Marwood; physician to both Elizabeth I and James I. He travelled to settle in Devon at the age of eighty, marrying his second and third wives at the respective ages of 87 and 94. It was his son who built Marwood House and he died in 1617, at Honiton, at the grand old age of 105. Only a few decades later, in 1653, a certain John Hill was listed in the parish records as "aged 103 or thereabouts"! Whilst a Peter Pearce left this world aged 99 in 1695, the next Honiton centenarian was not to be seen again until 1788 when local man John Hussey passed. The next such example in the town was not until 1867 when Charlotte Pike died aged 104. Longevities such as these were so rare at the time that the clerk actually made a point of writing their age in the register when only the date of burial and name were usually required.

Obviously, such long lives were even rarer in the smaller communities of

the surrounding villages, but there were still some notable individuals. Elizabeth Mitchell of Gittisham reached her centenary in 1830, and only a year later Buckerell put to rest Ann Marks who was an amazing 106. Mrs Marks' age was so unprecedented that the vicar not only re-wrote the age in words on the ledger but also added the comment "leaving more than 100 descendants".

Moving on into the twentieth century we come to Mary Sprague whose age, at the time, made her a local celebrity. She appeared on national newsreels, whilst being visited by the Mayor, Juanita Phillips, on her 101st birthday. Her secret to longevity was, as

she put it, "early to bed, early to rise and no 'faddy' feelings". A native of Kilmington, Mrs Sprague reminisced how she had walked the 25 miles from the village to Exeter to celebrate the taking of Sevastopol during the Crimean War in 1855. She passed away, in the town, the following year aged 102, being noted as "the only centenarian to have lived in the district within living memory".

The last and perhaps most astonishing was that of Devon born Emily Calvert, whose residency in Honiton actually broke national records for the town for a few months between 2004 and 2005. After losing her husband, in the 1960s, she moved to Honiton, from Northern Ireland, where she passed away on 13th January 2005 aged 111 at which time she was the oldest living person in England, having held the title since June 2004.

So is it genes or regimes that give one the potential to reach an age that Methuselah would be envious of? Presumably all you can do is either go for a jog, and knock that extra glass of wine on the head, or simply cling on to the fact that there was that second cousin on your mother's side who lived to be 96!

I have performed at private events; birthdays, anniversaries, in pubs, at outdoor events in East Devon. I am playing at an art exhibition launch in Sidmouth in November, and have a couple of local Christmas bookings. There is always room for more.

WHAT MAKES A BETTER RAILWAY?

Here at The Friends of Honiton Station one things matters above all: working with the railway community to help create a more successful railway. But that supposes that everyone agrees what that looks like. More frequent trains obviously, but that counts for little if they are cancelled or delayed.

Our friends at the campaign group Railfuture were brave enough to suggest what makes a successful railway. First and foremost is reliability. It is ironic that the reduced timetable introduced in August has actually been more reliable, with fewer delays. When the service returns to normal, everyone wants to see the same reliability maintained.

South Western Railway has worked hard to ensure there are enough seats on our trains. With most now running with six carriages, even peak time services are much improved.

Fares need to be value for money and simpler to understand. That said, we all need to do our bit as well. The number of times I have stood behind people queuing at Honiton to buy a ticket, and the staff member has asked if they have a Railcard, only to hear them say no. Any local travelling wholly within Devon and Cornwall can buy a Railcard that gives them 30% off all journeys after the morning peak. And there are a wide range of National Railcards offering the same discount. The Senior Card for older travellers is great value.

Passengers want to see journey times cut, better links between trains and buses, and easier connections when changing from one train to another.

Customer service is crucial, and here is where Honiton really hits the spot. Customers expect service to be helpful and efficient, with staff ready to go the extra mile to help passengers. Our staff at Honiton do that and more.

Nationalisation will soon bring those responsible for train and track back together, meaning the industry will be structured in a way that encourages people to work together, to put the customer first. But with that comes the need for renewed investment. We all know that money is



very tight at the moment. But investment in public transport is vital, to get people out of their cars, reducing congestion and cutting emissions.

As a perfect example, improving the line between Honiton and Exeter, which is supported by our local MP Richard Foord, local councils and a range of campaign groups including ourselves, would be a valuable investment in all our futures.




